

26th ANNUAL SHARK TOURNAMENT

With an increase in the prize money pool to \$60,000 plus custom trophies, prizes and calcuttas, this is the one shark tournament you won't want to miss. Last year, over \$438,000 was paid out; the big winners were the crew of Capt. Ed Poller's "Pea Pod," whose 154 lb. Mako netted the crew just shy of \$300,000! So mark your calendars for the 26th Annual Star Island Yacht Club Shark Tournament to be held from June 14-16, 2012. There are 12 Tournament prizes including \$30k for the Heaviest Qualifying fish in the Tournament; \$5k each day for the Heaviest Qualifying Fish; \$5k for the Heaviest Qualifying Mako; \$3500 for the Heaviest Qualifying Thresher/Hammerhead and \$2500 for the Heaviest Qualifying Blue Shark in the tournament. In addition there will be 7 calcuttas available ranging from \$200 to \$20,000 each.

The captain's meeting will be held on Thursday, June 14th, with fishing Friday and Saturday, June 15th and 16th. The awards ceremony and dinner will follow fishing on Saturday night, accompanied by live music and dancing under the stars!!

For those anglers who wish to get in on the action and don't own a boat, The Star Island Yacht Club charter fishing fleet is home to Montauk's finest and most knowledgeable charter captains. Their boats can accommodate up to 6 anglers and are available for ONE or BOTH days of the tournament!!

In addition to this outstanding competition, all sportsmen can contribute to the studies of the shark by tagging and releasing sharks that don't meet strict weight requirements. Last year, over 300 sharks were released back to the ocean. Of the sharks that were weighed in, over 750 pounds of edible shark meat was donated to the Long Island Council of Churches' food pantry to help feed those in need!

ENTRY FEE \$1,000 PER BOAT

RULES & REGULATIONS

- All boats must sail from and return through Lake Montauk each fishing day.
- Each boat will be issued a tournament number, which must be prominently displayed in the port side cabin window.
- 3. No boat may leave the inlet before 6:00 A.M. and boats must return by 6:00 P.M. on Fri. and 5:00 P.M. on Saturday.
- The prize category of the "Other Species" refers only to the minimum size species of Hammerhead and Thresher. Minimum weight: MAKO - 125 LBS., BLUE SHARK - 225 LBS., OTHER SPECIES - 150 LBS. FISH WEIGHED THAT DO NOT MEET THE MINIMUM WEIGHTS MAY COUNT AGAINST A TEAM'S QUALIFYING FISH WEIGHT.
- All I.G.F.A. tackle rules apply. Use of mammal blood or flesh is strictly prohibited. No guns, bang sticks or harpoons.
- Fishing will be held each scheduled day, Captain's choice, no weather committee. Only one day need be fished for the tournament to be considered official.
- 7. All fish must be available for weigh-ins at S.I.Y.C. by 6:00 P.M. on Friday and 5:00 P.M. on Saturday. Weights will be rounded to the nearest pound, with exact 1/2 pounds being rounded up.
- 8. Should there be a tie in any cash prize category, the prize money will be divided equally among the winners.
- 9. In the event of a category not having a winner, that prize money will be divided equally among winning categories.
- 10. In the event of a boat disability, contestants are allowed to transfer to another boat not entered in the Tournament, and fish in the name of the original. Fish may not be transferred to another boat.
- 11. Any protests must be presented, at the time of the alleged infraction, to the Tournament Directors. They, and the Weighmaster, shall serve as judges in such cases and their decision is final.
- In the event of a two-day blow, as per boat safety and judge's decision, prize monies and trophies will be awarded by a drawing.
